

Requirements for EUR-students

IBA courses are only available for students who are currently enrolled in an **English**-taught Bachelor programme from a Dutch research university and who meet the general admission requirements for the BSc IBA programme (please refer to the overall grade, mathematics, and English requirements on the www.rsm.nl/bsciba site). If you do not meet the requirements or if you have not been granted permission to follow a course due to capacity restrictions, you will be notified by email.

Please note: it is only possible to follow elective courses free of charge if you have not previously obtained a Bachelor's degree. More information can be found [here](#).

Deadline application

To prevent delays, we strongly recommend you to register before the start of a new block so that your login account is created before the block starts.

Elective courses of the fall semester (September – December 2022) are now available:

- Block 1 and 5 = start 29 Augustus 2022 (no courses open for elective students).
- Block 2 and 6 = start 24 October 2022.

Application deadline: 1 October 2022

Application procedure

Register for an elective course via the registration form (at the bottom of this document) and send this form by email to bsc.pm@rsm.nl.

When returning the registration form you must include the following documents:

- Statement from your programme's Examination Board granting you permission to follow the courses of International Business Administration as an elective course
- Proof of mathematics proficiency
- Official transcript indicating the number of completed EC (grade list) at your programme

You will receive a message from BSc Programme Management about your placement as soon as possible via an admission letter per email.

Please note:

* EUR-students do **not** have to register via Studielink to follow elective courses at the EUR.

* IBCoM-students do not need to fill out this form and should contact their Programme Coordinator at ESHCC directly to follow elective courses at RSM.
