

Requirements for non-EUR students

IBA courses are only available for students who are currently enrolled in an English-taught Bachelor programme from a Dutch research university and who meet the general admission requirements for the BSc IBA programme (please refer to the overall grade, mathematics, and English requirements on the www.rsm.nl/bsciba site). If you do not meet the requirements or if you have not been granted permission to follow a course due to capacity restrictions, you will be notified by email.

Please note: it is only possible to follow elective courses free of charge if you have not previously obtained a Bachelor's degree. More information can be found [here](#).

Deadline application

To prevent delays, we strongly recommend you to register well before the start of a new block so that your login account is created before the block starts.

Elective courses of the Spring semester (January – June 2023) are now available:

- Block 3A and 3B - *Application deadline: 11 December 2022 (no block 7 courses open for elective students)
- Block 4 and 8 - *Application deadline: 1 March 2023

**Late registrations will not be accepted*

Application procedure for external students

Please follow this procedure for **non-EUR** (Erasmus University Rotterdam) students:

1. Sign into [Studielink](#) for the elective courses of RSM you wish to take. Search in Studielink for 'Elective course'. Once you've completed your enrolment request in Studielink, you'll receive an email through your ERNA account within 24 hours
2. After receiving this email, go to [OSIRIS student](#) and sign in with your ERNA account. Click on 'Case' in OSIRIS, and subsequently hit 'Start a new case'. Select the case 'Requesting elective(s) as a non-EUR student'.
3. In the case, you can select the electives that you'd like to take and finalize the submission of the request, up to a max. of two courses per period. Upload the following attachments:
 - Statement from your programme's Examination Board granting you permission to follow the courses of International Business Administration as an elective course
 - Proof of mathematics proficiency
 - Official transcript indicating the number of completed EC (grade list) at your programme
4. After submitting your case, your request is assessed by RSM. Please note: you need to go through all the steps for your request to be processed.
5. Send your Proof of Tuition Fee Payment of your own university to the EUR Student Administration at edf.es@eur.nl. Upload your passport size photo through the link you've received in your email.
6. Important: only students who meet the requirements will be considered for the elective courses!

If you have not received a confirmation from RSM 5 working days before the start of the course, please contact us asap via bsc.pm@rsm.nl.
