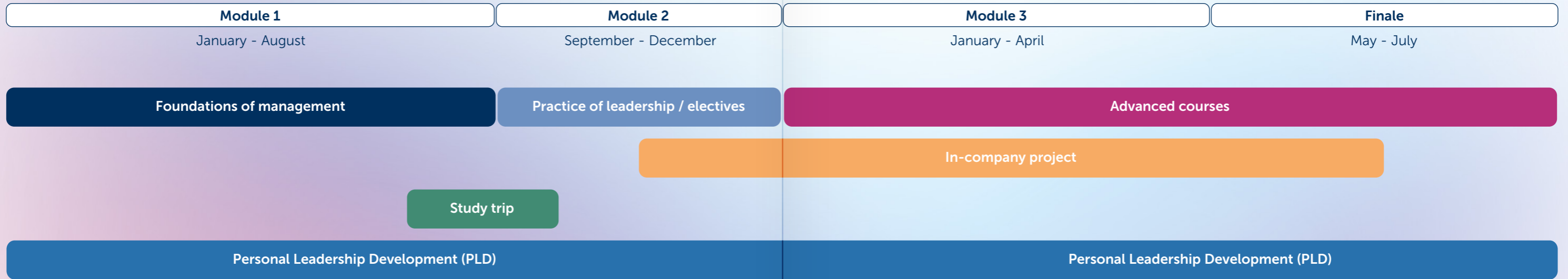


Transform the present Change the future

Now offered as optional tracks alongside your EMBA study, the specialised **Entrepreneurship Through Acquisition (ETA)** and **Impact Investment** trajectories expand your entrepreneurial toolkit. The ETA track teaches you how to work with and start your own search fund, focusing on the identification, acquisition and growth of established businesses. The Impact Investment track, in collaboration with Maas Impact Ventures, equips you to support purpose-driven ventures and contribute to building a thriving ecosystem for impactful, measurable change.
