Payment in full could qualify for discount. Below is an example of a payment plan.

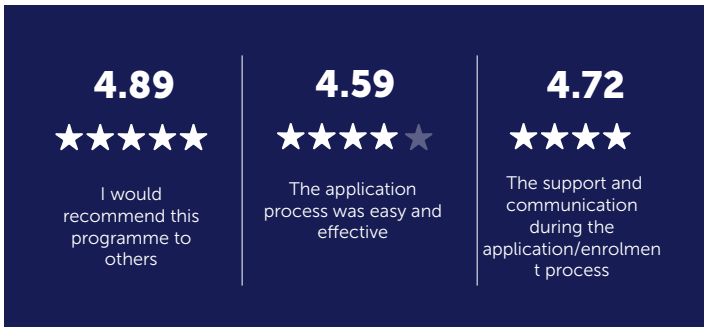

Start dates & deadlines

Intakes start in September and March. The application deadline operates on a rolling basis. However, this means that if the maximum number of students for the cohort is reached, applications will close. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to apply early to secure their place for their desired intake.
