

Requirements

IBA courses are only available for students who are currently enrolled in an English-taught Bachelor programme from a Dutch research university and who meet the general admission requirements for the BSc IBA programme (please refer to the overall grade, mathematics, and English requirements on the www.rsm.nl/bsciba site). If you do not meet the requirements or if you have not been granted permission to follow a course due to capacity restrictions you will be notified by email.

Please note: it is only possible to follow elective courses free of charge if you have not previously obtained a Bachelor's degree. More information at: <https://www.eur.nl/en/education/practical-matters/financial-matters/tuition-fee/explanation-tuition-fees>

Deadline application

To prevent delays, we strongly recommend you to register 30 days before the start of a new trimester, so that your student card and login account is created before the trimester starts.

The trimesters start on:

- 4th trimester = 2 September 2019. Application recommendation: before 1 August 2019. Application for the minor runs from 1 to 31 May 2020. See <https://www.eur.nl/en/education/minors> for more information.
- 5th and 8th trimester = 6 January 2020. Application notification: before 1 December 2019.
- 6th and 9th trimester = 30 March 2020. Advice on application: before 1 March 2020.

Application procedure

Register for an elective course via the registration form (at the bottom of this document) and send this form by e-mail to bsc.pm@rsm.nl or by post to:

When returning the registration form you must include the following documents:

- Statement from your programme's Examination Board granting you permission to follow the courses of International Business Administration as an elective course;
- Proof of enrolment for the 2019-2020 academic year (from the programme you are currently studying). Please note: this is not necessary if you are a EUR student;
- Proof of mathematics proficiency;
- Official transcript indicating the number of completed EC (grade list) at your programme.

You will receive a message from BSc Programme Management as soon as possible about your placement, via an admission letter.

Please note: you do not have to register via Studielink to follow elective courses at the EUR.

If you are not yet a student at the EUR, you will receive – after being enrolled as an elective student – a **proof of registration** and a **student ID card** (after you have uploaded your passport photo via a sent link) from the EDF (Enrolment, Deregistration and Funding). You will also receive an ERNA login account and password, which you will need to log into our systems SIN-Online, Osiris student and Canvas.
