These capacity restrictions are: 170 for the specialisation Accounting & Financial Management, 70 for the specialisation Master in Management (full-time), 120 for the specialisation Master in Management (part-time) and 90 for the specialisation Business Analytics & Management.

The CROHO number refers to a unique programme number under which the MSc programme is registered in the Dutch central register for higher educational programmes.

All above mentioned MSc programmes have a nominal study duration of 12-months except: 1. The International Management (60256) programme, which has a nominal study duration of 18 months, and (2) The part-time Business Administration programme (60644) with the specialisation Master in Management, which has a nominal study duration of 24 months.
